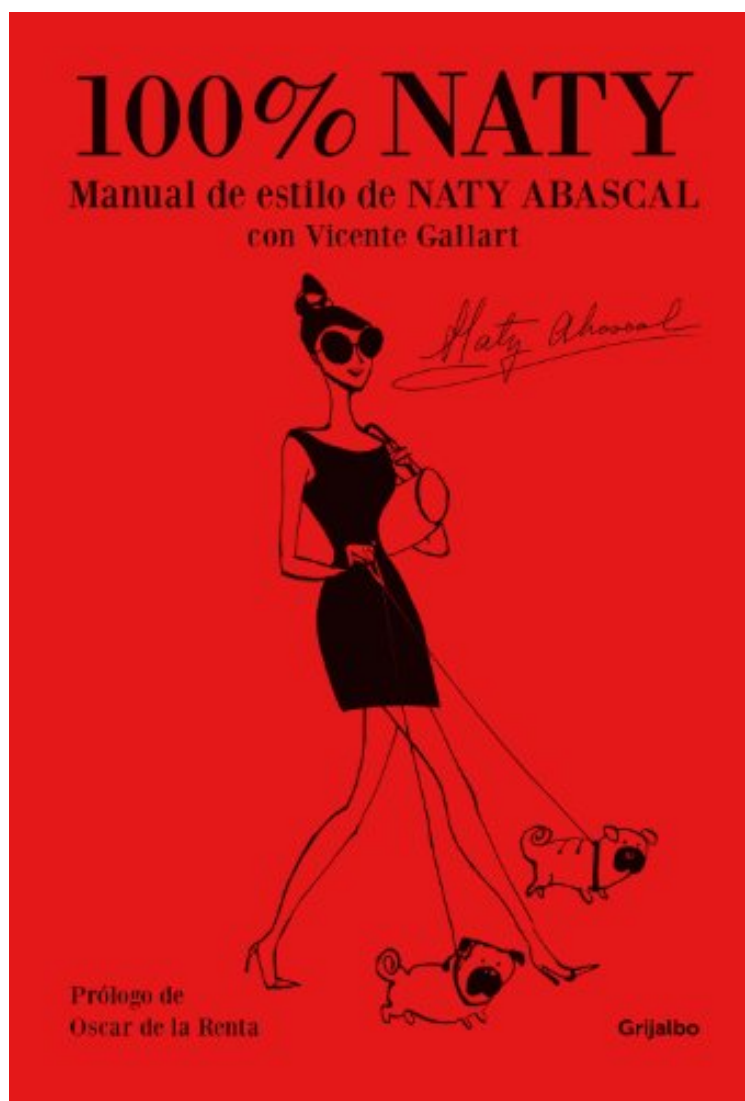

However, what I found very annoying while reading this book was her frequent use of English words and phrases, where a Spanish word or phrase would have been just fine and a lot less pedantic. Was she trying to sound "cool"? It did not work for me. Her editors even didn't catch some

words that were just plain wrong. For instance, she used "sleepers", where she meant "slippers" and should have stuck with the Spanish word for slippers, which is zapatillas.
