

Although I believe this book wasn't necessarily intended for newbies, it has enough information and fantastic pictures depicting everything you need to know. As a beginner, I

can't attest to whether or not the projects actually take 24 hours to make as the name implies, but since they are so easy, I assume anyone who has been making quilts a while could easily make any of them in the time allotted. My favorite patterns where the pinwheel patterns, especially the rugged pinwheels. I am making it for my bed, but I could see it being a great baby quilt as well. I'll admit I didn't like some of the fabrics used in the book, but that doesn't take away from the quilt patterns themselves. Changing out the fabric choices is easy enough.

You can't tell by looking at them but each of these 32 projects takes 24 hours or less to sew! Ideal for people who love to sew but don't have as much free time as they'd like, the quick and easy patterns are also great for whipping up personalized gifts for the holidays. Full-color photos illustrate simple directions for making accessories for the kitchen, from pretty potholders to a reversible apron. For the bedroom, patterns include a duvet cover and a variety of pillows. Make terrific towels for the bathroom, and for the nursery you can create a quickie quilt, blanket, and bonnet. Projects also include Christmas ornaments that will help dress up your home for the holidays as well as an assortment of unique gifts — purses and totes, jackets, a vest, and more.

**About the Author** Although an experienced crafter, Linda Causee had never quilted until she was hired to do so by a local needlework publishing company. Soon after, she was promoted to quilt editor, and she has since written many books on the subject, including 365 Foundation Quilt Blocks and Quilts A to Z.
