

As we progress, each menu for establishing pre-sets for cameras, lighting, 3D modeling, texturing and so forth is illustrated and is accompanied by screen-saved images so we can see the project taking shape when we apply each menu. By the time we're into Chapter 7 (of 12), our handling of the menus seems to come naturally. Stephen's use of short, direct texts combined with his many stunning images makes this instructional book a delight. The book demonstrates how easy it is for Photoshop users to work in 3D with third-party software, to import 3D objects, create 3D lettering, to output Photoshop 3D designs using 3D printers and much more.
