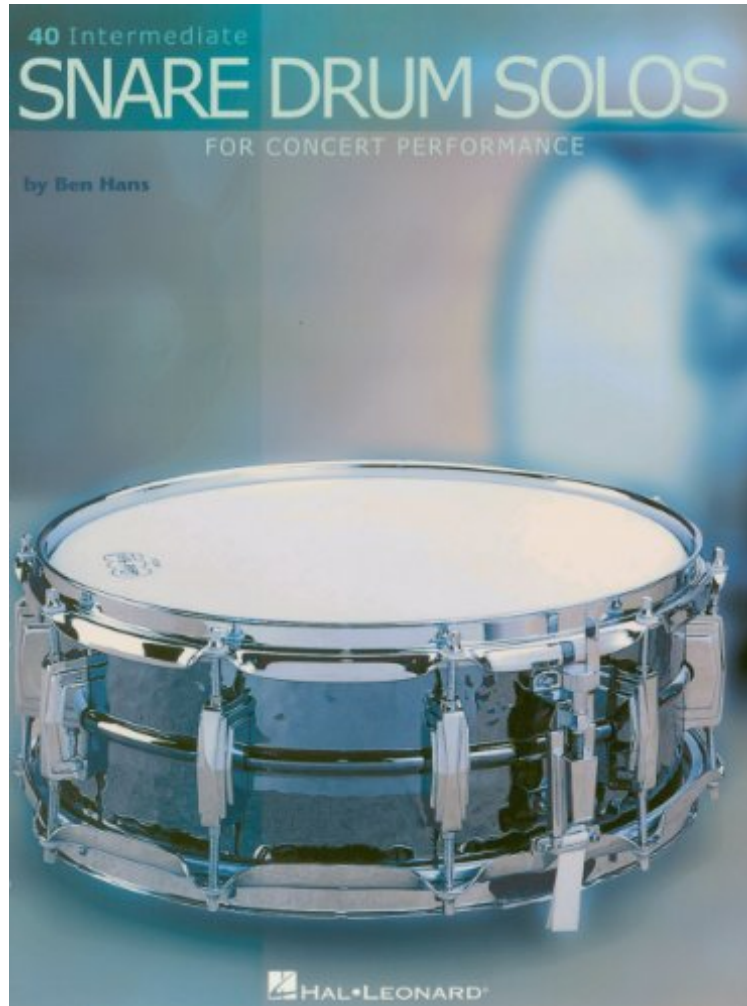

I would reccommend that you add this to the requesite Anthony Cirone and Wilcoxen books that serve as the foundation for Concert Snare Drum and Marching solos. 10 minutes a day with this book and a metronome will turn you into a drumming BEAST. they need to work on. The book is exactly what it says it is: 40 "intermediate" snare drum solos. The only reason why I didn't give this book 5 stars is because there are many books like this that came out before this book; while it is a good book, there's nothing amazing and progressive about it--and surely, that was most likely not the point of this book. However, for a listing price of \$7.95, this book is definitely worth it, ESPECIALLY for someone who is just looking for a book with trickier snare drum solos. Another alternative book you might want to check out is Mitchell Peters "Intermediate Snare Drum Studies" (unfortunately .com does not yet have this book, WHY??) or Roy Burns "Intermediate Drum Method".
