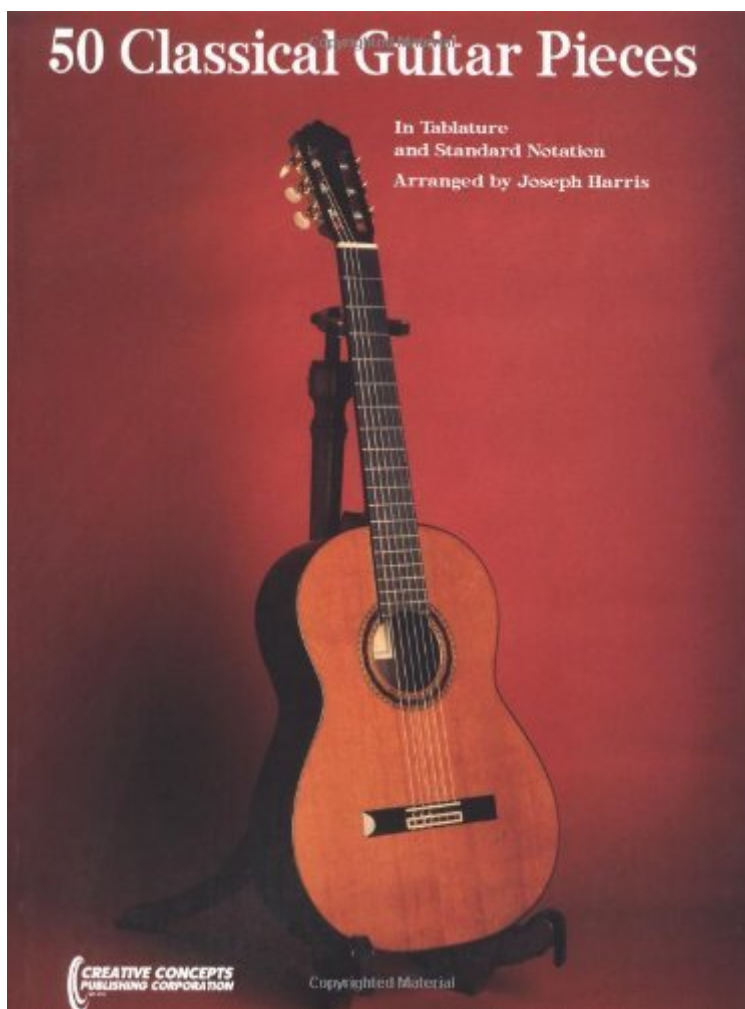

By camperdave I picked up the Kindle version mainly, because I like to read sheet music from my iPad. Mostly I read very clear PDF files, but this book was scanned poorly for Kindle. Some of the tablature notes are hard to read, and as a matter of fact even if I use my iMac to view the Kindle desktop version it's still blurry. It required me to zoom in to try to figure out the notes, then just memorize that part. Otherwise the book itself has some really fun easy-to-play songs. ...and the guy who wrote it seems like an interesting fellow. His bio reads as he is a real outdoor adventurer. 3 stars for the less-than-perfect display of the music notes in Kindle, otherwise for the content a 4 or 5 star book for me.
