Spending two weeks in a closed shelter eating chili and beans would be trying for anyone, and the play hinges on the stresses and strains of two people who don't really like each other trapped together in very close confines for a period of time not knowing what awaits them outside. 'After the End' had its world premiere at the Traverst Theatre on August 5, 2005.
