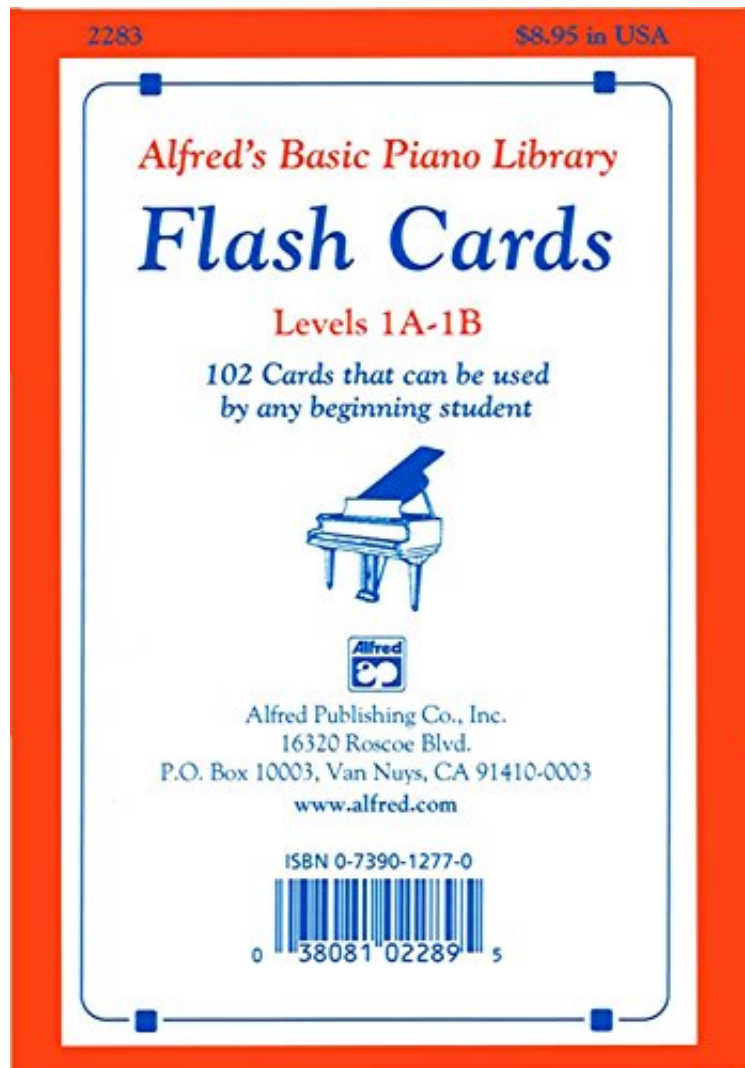

It has a picture of the different type of notes (quarter, whole, etc.) all the different signs (rest, 3/4, 4/4, crescendo, etc.)It also has the flashcards for the notes, it does not include the entire base and treble clef. My set went from low A, up to about

D on the treble clef. I wanted ones that also include the notes beyond the clef (high or low C for example). Also, it has some of the keys, but it only included 2 of them, only C and G Major. I was very disappointed that it did not include all of the main keys. The paper is thick and the size is good (easy to read), but there are more than 100 cards, and they are all loose. I thought some kind of clip or ring would be helpful. Also, there is one hole at the top middle, a horrible place if I were to clip them together. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
