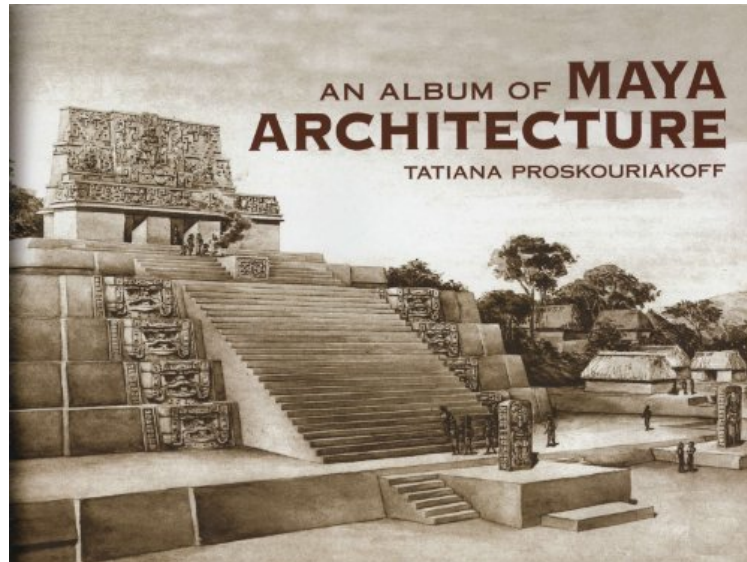

Stout This book is in part dated by subsequent archaeological research, and treats only 11 of the Mayan cities (very unevenly, per the times). But the author is legendary in the annals of Mayan studies and provides here authoritative and elegant artist-reconstructions of major edifices from these places, giving us a glimpse of how they were seen by the ancients. The accompanying text is likewise elegant. To be classed as an antiquarian book now, this remains a worthy addition to the library of those with enthusiasm for ancient Mesoamerica.

Magnificent guide presents 36 sites from Central America and southern Mexico as they appeared more than a thousand years ago: Temple of the Cross, Palenque; Acropolis and Maya sweat bath, Piedras Negras; Red House and north terrace at Chichén Itzá; more. Each illustration features text of archeological finds and line drawing of remains. 95 illustrations.
