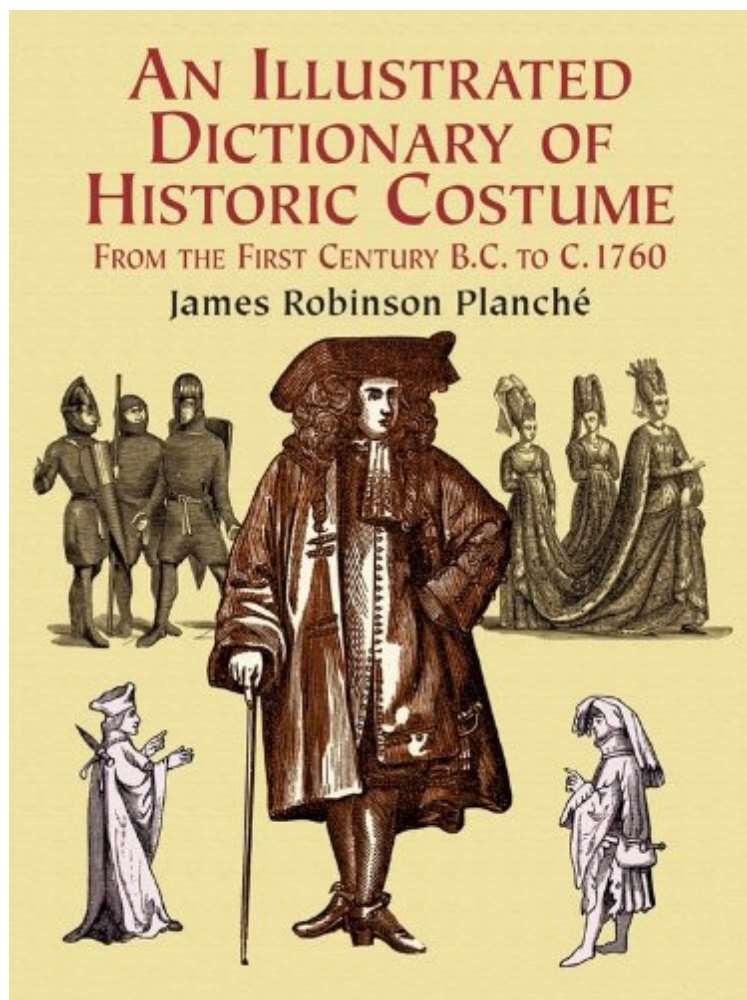


## An Illustrated Dictionary of Historic Costume (Dover Fashion and Costumes)
