

The repeated criticism of the "commodification" of architecture is oddly validated by successfully commodity businesses. The books central idea of 'disruption' as a positive, innovative effect on the incumbent technology is an interesting perspective but the author fails to make it relevant to architecture in my opinion - at least not for other than mega size corporate firms.
