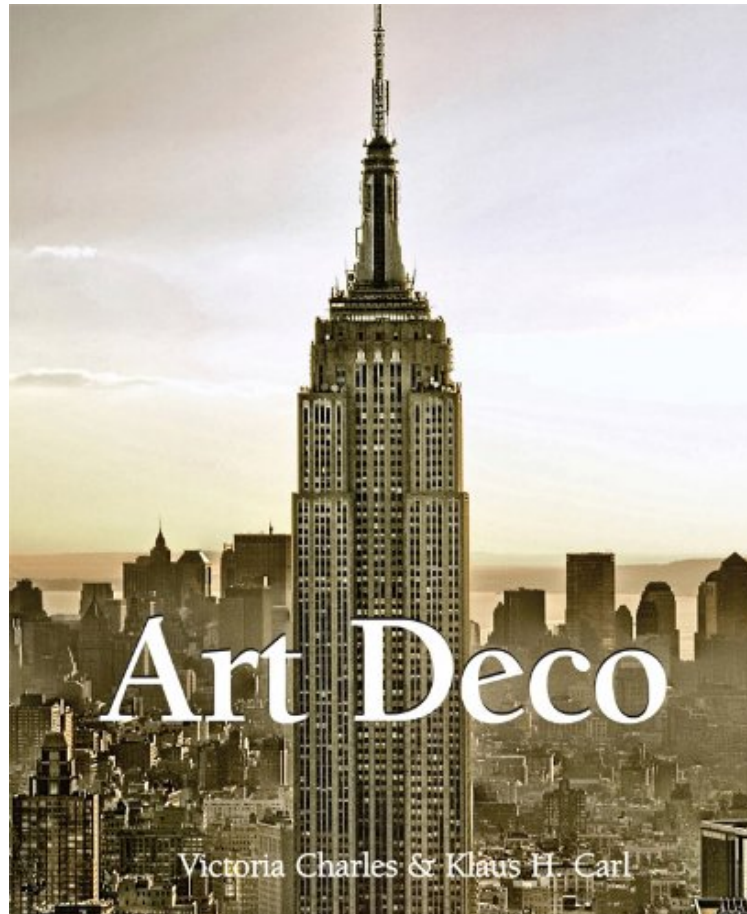

Eisman I have a large library on Art Deco books built over many years, and this new book is the worst of the lot. It offers very little background on the origins of art deco or its best moments in terms of architecture and design, or what the movement really means. Tellingly, the publisher doesn't even tell the reader where its authors received their degrees or any other basic information that a reasonable informed reader would want to know. Virtually all of the artwork and photos in the books are clichés, in that they have appeared in dozens of books over the past couple of decades. I'd bet that there is not a SINGLE ORIGINAL taken-for-this-book image in the entire volume! The publisher should be ashamed of bringing this volume to market, though my guess is that they have no shame.

Art Deco style was established on the ashes of a disappeared world, the one from before the First World War, and on the foundation stone of a world yet to become, opened to the most undisclosed promises. Forgetting herself in the

whirl of Jazz Age and the euphoria of the "Art Deco", the Garconne with her linear shape reflects the architectural style of Art Deco: to the rounded curves succeed the simple and plain androgynous straight line... Architecture, painting, furniture and sculpture, dissected by the author, proclaim the virtues for sharp lines and broken angles. Although ephemeral, this movement keeps on influencing contemporary design.
