

This is a real Kickstarter for sure! By S. Warfield I absolutely love art journals. I must have just about every art journaling book that is in print. But I haven't yet started my own out of pure fear. That white paper page grows legs and a voice that dances around and says, "Nah, nah, you can't do this and do it perfectly." Then I got this book and on page 27, down in the right corner there is a quote that says, "The illusion of perfection is the enemy of happiness and creativity." That is the truest thing I've heard all day. I even dog-eared the page and I never dog-ear lovely books such as this one. What astounded me was a photo of a two-page example from artist Belinda Spiwak. It is done on a lined paper notebook and is titled "Evidence/Gecko." On the right page several pages are torn off at differing lengths and what look like stamps or stencils of three geckos are placed on that page. On the left page different light colors swirl and at the outer edge is either stamped or stenciled, "Evidence." with deep red and orange and green colors used. I read about it and the artist made and used it as inspiration for her fifth graders' own journals. The book is full of examples and prompts.
