

I believe it is the complete version of two other publications (same author) that were separated and made into a CD-ROM format. Easier on the books binding to have a CD, but this is the cheapest way to get all of the beautiful designs. I gave this book a 4 star rating, because some of the pictures are crudely drawn and the lines are not as crisp as I would like. Many of them do not color well when scanned in and transferred to art programs. If you are happy with the black and white illustrations provided, then you are good to go. Even with the color limits of the scanned illustrations, I have used this book so much that it's wearing out! I plan to buy another copy so that I can cut out the pages of the first book for better scanning. The thickness of the book makes
