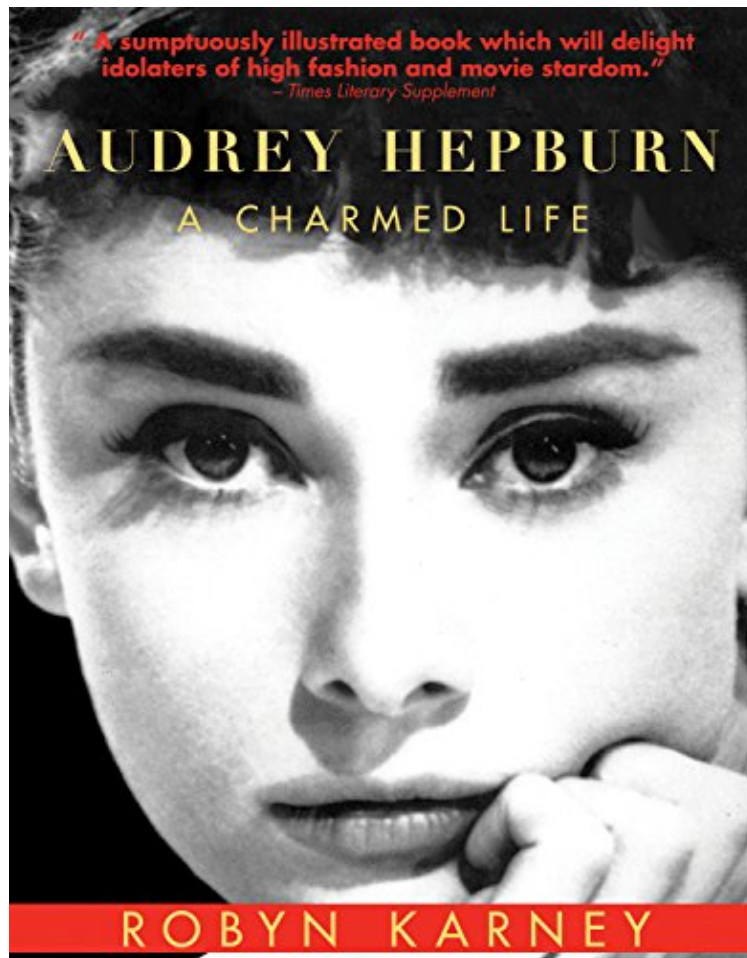

Her personality and sensuous yet untouchable beauty made her irresistible to the public.
