

By Moola Saver Maynard Solomon (84) has worn several hats over his long life--producer of records, writer of books, writer of album notes, and musicologist knowledgeable in at least five languages. His interest in Marxism and his psychological interpretations of musicians are well known among music scholars. In our book his 22-chapter, 554-page Beethoven (the greatest composer ever) biography is the most scholarly and thought-provoking so far and unlikely to be matched. He divides the music of Beethoven into four periods--Bonn, Vienna, the Heroic Period, and the Final Phase; his insights into our beloved composer's music are concise and creative.
